Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chief Ramm at 8:30 a.m.

Minute Approval

The meeting minutes from February were distributed for review. Chief Lobo moved to approve, Chief Hartbarger seconded. All approved the minutes.

Committee Reports

Paramedic Committee

Chief Ramm gave an update on paramedic committee meeting from March. Those draft minutes were distributed for review.

Medical Committee

Dr Lindstrom gave an update from Medical Committee which met Monday April 4th. Those draft minutes were distributed for review.

Systems Process Analyst

Dennis gave an update, Jon Ziehr was hired for this role. He will be working within the system about the future of EMS. Jon said he will be meeting with each County Commissioner, and will be reaching out to fire chiefs and working with elected officials.

CE Update

Aiden said March went well, will be in person for April and May as well. Will be giving folks physical handouts.

EMS Billing Update

Vicki for March revenue 361,837.97 YTD 1,027,354 and we are on budget so far.

ProMedica Maumee FSED

Dennis said they have a radio but we are still waiting for vending machines. There have been some complaints where vehicles are having to go past St Lukes because they're being directed to Maumee freestanding. Complication is that St Lukes doesn't exist on the Anthony Wayne Trail, and when these factors are put into GIS, Maumee freestanding becomes closest. Have adjusted speeds on "private" road around St Lukes. Eric and Greg tested this yesterday and it looks like it is working. Let us know if you're having any ongoing issues with this. Only an issue when going east bound on the Trail.

New Paramedic Orientation update

Chief Hartbarger said there is a meeting next week. They will focus on non-operating requirements. Chief Ramm thanked Chief Hartbarger, Craig Koperski and Lt Reed for their work on this.

Open Discussion

Mike said he's finally back on the PM rotation with the squads. Asking crews to make a punch list so issues are getting fixed faster. Dennis said a few years ago used power cots were purchased, found out that one of the used cots is not serviceable by Stryker because it was in a vehicle accident. It was resold to us and is perfectly functioning but because it was in an accident they are no longer repairable. Chief lobo asked if we've looked into BWC grant program – Dennis and Mike said they will look into this.

Byrd asked if there is data out there about reduction of back injuries, Chief Ramm said BWC should have that data.

Dennis gave an update that Nikki, the lead CE administrator is looking at a different position and would like to stay on part time but has not given us a schedule. This is being looked at.

Chief Mullins asked where we are at with Pulse Point. Dennis said they are still working on the servers.

The next Policy Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 1, 2022. Chief Mullins motioned to adjourn at 8:54. Chief Lobo seconded. All approved. Meeting was adjourned.
