Call to Order

Chief Cousino called the meeting to order at 10:30 am.

Minute Approval

The meeting minutes from April 10 were distributed for review. Chief Ramm made a motion to approve. Chief Armstrong second. All approve.

Committee Reports

Paramedic Committee

The draft minutes from May Paramedic Committee meeting were distributed for review. Dr Lindstrom reviewed the minutes.

Medical Committee

The draft minutes from April's Medical Committee meeting were distributed for review. Chief Cousino discussed the Medical Committee meeting this morning. Draft minutes will be distributed before the next meeting.

EMS System Modernization

One EMT and One Paramedic : no movement on this, waiting on the state board of EMS. Amendment to current contract on hold. Dr Lindstrom said he and Ralph have been working together to identify for dispatchers which incidents still need two paramedics on scene. Once they finish initial discussion will try to put together a report of how frequent that may happen. Will give us a sense of what impact this change will have on day to day function. Will have by next meeting. If you have a lot of questions should sit down with Dr Lindstrom and Ralph so they can go through the details.

Modernization Update : Dennis said they are in process of having regional meetings.

Jon discussed splitting and dividing of assets. He has been meeting with all jurisdictions. All assets will not be pulled back in to the county. Whatever assets Chiefs have will stay there. Vending machines have been discussed as well. Will come with delivery, would be moved to whichever fire department wants them. Service contract needs to be transferred to that jurisdiction. Service contract is about \$2500 per year per set. Jon is waiting on Waterville and Whitehouse to respond on whether they want them or not. Lifesquads, first three LS coming in one is scheduled Q4 2023 two other are possibly Q4 2024. If LS 10 is totaled, that would be replaced with one of those new rigs. To date, no fire chief has stated they don't want a fully stocked unit. Backup rigs will be equipped based on available spare equipment including lifepaks and autovents.

CE equipment list – Chief Mullins heading up CE sub committee that gets all the medical directors together and linking up protocols. Put list out of high ticket items for review and is

hearing a lot of chatter from fire chiefs that it might be nice to break up into regions for shared use.

Dennis clarified that the demo they're doing with mercy Perrysburg starts tomorrow June 6th at 7am. Open radio on med channel 12 to contact Mercy Perrysburg directly instead of going through dispatch.

CE Update

Mark Briggs said ACLS is complete. Currently working on CE for next 8 hours. Should be out on EMS1 by middle of June. Eight one hour programs for Paramedics to complete by the end of October.

EMS Billing Update

Month of May \$370,191.34 brought actual YTD 1,680,501.85. Estimated budget for this year is \$4 million so right on track for that.

Lights and Sirens

White paper was distributed. Still in conversation. Chief Armstrong asked if in response to incident or transport to hospital? Chief Cousino said both, they're trying to reduce code 3 all around. No written policy about which are code 3 vs code 2. Chief Cousino said he doesn't think we need a policy, it is situational. Chief Armstrong said in her experience when her drivers have tried to slow down dispatch won't allow it. Dennis said he needs some kind of policy saying this is the plan. Not gaining any patient care value by going lights and sirens, may be causing more situations because of accidents. Chief Ramm asked if that was something Dr Lindstrom and Ralph could look at as they're going through the cards? Dr Lindstrom said they do not want to create conflict between dispatch and the departments. He perceived it as a fire chief issue – it is how they operate, not a medical director issue. Ralph said if they have someone on scene requesting code 2 they will slow them down. Chief Armstrong said they are already policing that. Dr Lindstrom said the next step would be to go through cards in detail with a group of fire chiefs and deciding if they are comfortable with the COG making adjustments. Dennis said if there is a first responder on scene why does the responding lifesquad need to go code 3? Dr Lindstrom and Ralph will work a couple chiefs to put together a list of codes.
