Purpose of Meeting

The purpose of this open house meeting is to update you on the proposed project, present preliminary design and right-of-way information, and seek your feedback.

Project Purpose and Goals

The purpose of this project is to:

- 1. Improve Interstate access for the communities served by Dorr Street;
- 2. Enhance system linkage to support the local area transportation goals established in The Dorr Street Corridor Vision Plan 2009;
- 3. Support local land use and development plans for the University of Toledo and the local neighborhoods as defined in The Dorr Street Corridor Vision Plan 2009; and
- 4. Improve Emergency Services response time for Springfield Township.

The project proposes a new multilane roundabout interchange on I-475 at Dorr Street, and increasing the roadway lanes on Dorr Street from 2 through lanes to 4 through lanes with a two-way center left turn lane between McCord Road and Holland Sylvania Road. A 5 foot wide sidewalk on both sides of the street with a 6 foot wide tree lawn between the sidewalk and the street is also being evaluated for the project. Noise walls, drainage, intersection, traffic control, maintenance of traffic, utility, and culvert improvements conforming to ODOT, Lucas County, and City of Toledo standards will be included in the project as well as new service roads and improved access to the Cuba-Saturn Park.

Project Area Map

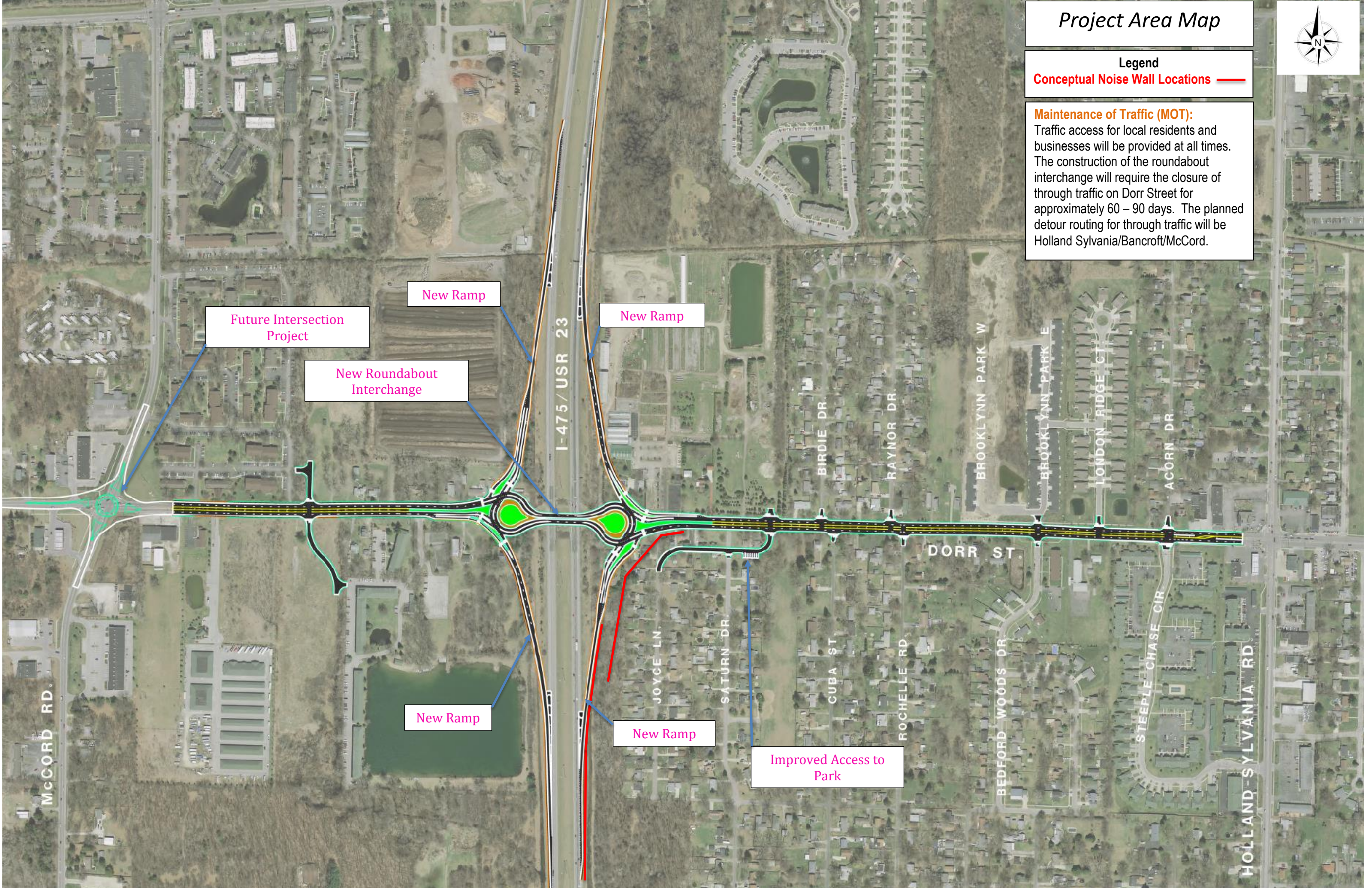
