




# PLEASE COMMENT on proposed changes to Cuba Saturn Park due to **Proposed IR475/Dorr St Interchange**



The Lucas County Transportation Improvement District (LCTID), in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), proposes to construct a new roundabout interchange on I-475 at Dorr Street. The project would impact Cuba Saturn Park, which is a 5.2103 acre neighborhood park with green space and trees at 6300 Dorr Street that is owned and maintained by the City of Toledo. (ODOT Project ID 99737)

#### **Park Changes:**

### **During Construction:**

- Park access will be maintained at Joanne Place, Calla Lane, and Cuba Street
- Park access closed at Dorr Street only during construction
- Temporary construction fencing will be placed between the park and construction

- New connection from Dorr St. to Saturn Dr. and Joyce Ln. This will change 0.1658 acres from park to access
- **New 7-Space Parking Lot**
- Add 0.0933 acres to the park
