

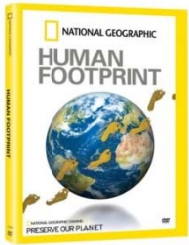

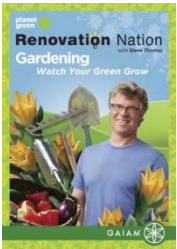

Renovation Nation: Gardening - Watch Your Green Grow

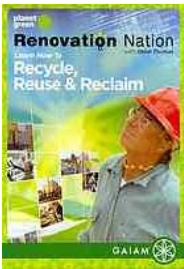

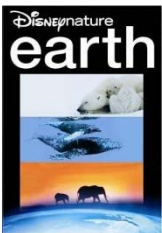
Renewable Energy

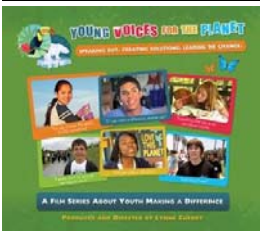

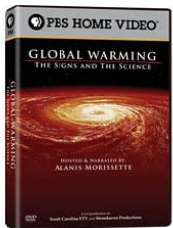

The Clean Bin Project

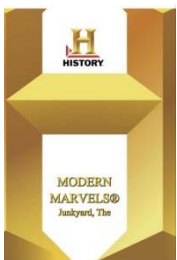

History -- Modern Marvels: The Junkyard

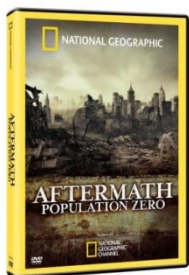

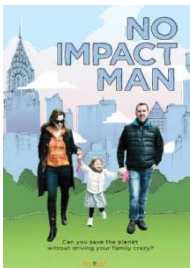


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No Impact Man

Bag It!

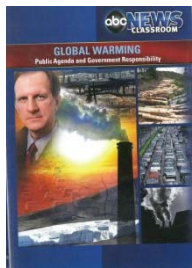

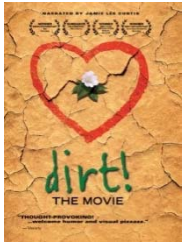


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Dirt! The Movie

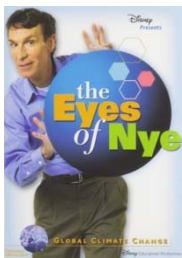

The Eyes of Nye: Global Climate Change

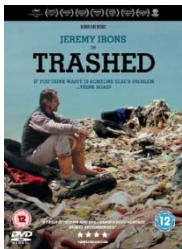
