

Health Insurance Compliance Order

Medical Support Order

1. The party ordered to maintain health insurance coverage for the minor child(ren) shall provide to the other party, no later than thirty (30) days from the issuance of this order, information regarding the health insurance coverage, including benefits, limitations and any exclusions in coverage. The party required to maintain health insurance coverage shall provide, within thirty (30) days any necessary insurance forms and a copy of any necessary insurance cards.
2. The health plan administrator may continue making payment for medical, optical, hospital, dental, or prescription services directly to any health care provider in accordance with the applicable insurance policy, contract or plan.
3. The party ordered to maintain health insurance for the minor child(ren) shall designate the minor child(ren) as covered dependents under any private health insurance policy, contract or plan for which the party contracts until further order of the Court.
4. The parties shall comply with all provisions contained in the Court's Medical Schedule.
5. The employer of the party hereby ordered to maintain health insurance for the minor child(ren) shall, upon written request, release to the other parent, or the Lucas County Child Support Enforcement Agency, any necessary information on the private health insurance coverage, including the name and address of the health plan administrator and any policy, contract, or plan number. Said employer shall comply with all provisions of Ohio Revised Code §3119.32 including all orders and notices issued pursuant to the provision.
6. The parties shall comply with all provisions contained in R.C. §3119.30 and §3119.32(A) and (C) no later than thirty (30) days from the issuance of this order. The obligor must notify the Lucas County Child Support Enforcement Agency when private health insurance is no longer available at a reasonable cost.
7. Upon receipt of notice by the Lucas County Child Support Enforcement Agency that private health insurance is not available at a reasonable cost, cash medical shall be paid in the amount determined pursuant to R.C. §3119.022 or §3119.023; as applicable. **The Lucas County Child Support Enforcement Agency may change the financial obligations of the parties in accordance with the Court or administrative order without further hearing or additional notice to the parties.**

NOTICE

If the person required to obtain private health insurance coverage for the child(ren), subject to this child support order, obtains new employment, the Lucas County Child Support Enforcement Agency shall comply with the requirements of Section §3119.34 of the Revised Code, which may result in the issuance of a notice requiring the new employer to take whatever action is necessary to enroll the child(ren) in private health care insurance coverage provided by the new employer.
