

INTERSYSTEM CARE COORDINATION SUMMARY

This summary provides an overview of the services and support that are available to families through the Lucas County Family and Children First Council's Intersystem Care Coordination Plan. The goal is to make sure families can get the right help at the right time, in a way that is easy to understand and centered on family needs.

FOR FAMILIES

Information and Referral

Helps connect families to the right services and/or supports in the community. This may include a warm hand-off to Family Navigators who help guide families to the best resources.

Wraparound

Wraparound is a strength-based planning process where a team works with a child and their family to help them with their underline unmet needs. This team includes people important to the child and family, like relatives, friends, neighbors, and service providers. The goal is to create a personalized plan, by utilizing unique interventions to help the family achieve better outcomes and become less reliant on the systems and more resilient with new skills and abilities.



Intersystem Placements:

When children are at risk of harming themselves or others, short-term placements in safe environments may be provided. The focus is always on working with families to bring children back home as quickly and safely as possible.

Diversion Services:

For youth who come into contact with the Juvenile Court, diversion programs connect them to support and services instead of detention, helping them get back on track in healthier ways.

Collaborating with Families

These services are designed to support families in ways that are family-centered, culturally respectful, and focused on strengths. Every plan is unique to each child and family, with the goal of keeping families together and building brighter futures.
