Fix your home with No-Cost Home Repair and Private Owner Rehabilitation


The Lucas County Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) program offers home repairs and rehabilitations to income-eligible Lucas County homeowners (excluding the City of Toledo). Repairs may include roofs, water heaters, furnaces, A/C, electric panel, electrical, ADA modifications, plumbing, and more.

The **Home Repair Program** provides no-cost upgrades and fixes for qualified homeowners. This grant-funded program requires no repayment by the homeowner.

The **Home Rehabilitation Program** offers more extensive repairs and upgrades for homes. Assistance will be in the form of a declining-forgivable loan. There is no monthly payment, and no interest will be charged. No credit check is needed. 100% of the amount borrowed will be forgiven over (5) years provided owner continues to own and occupy the home.
